Re: Year 13 PPEs

Your Year 13 son/daughter will be sitting their pre-public examinations (PPEs) the week beginning 6th January 2025 and these exams will give teachers vital information on areas of strengths, weakness, and misconceptions at an individual level as they build towards their public exams in the summer term. Exams run for a two-week period and all students are expected in school for the entire period, attending lessons if they are not in exams.

Students should be revising from now and over the Christmas holiday, so, with this in mind, we have asked subject teachers and curriculum leaders for all subjects to provide key revision information for this preparation, to support students focus and also to inform parents so they can support accordingly. Extended day provision has also been provided in some subject areas.

Your support in the coming months will be a major factor in your child's successes; encouragement and motivation to plan and complete revision is your major role. Please see the separate document with the PPE timetable. Students have the option to see their teachers for support if required and should remain on the school site to study during the school day if not in lessons. Any Year 13 who does leave site during the day, must be back in time for their exam/lessons.

Please note that the start time for all AM examinations is 08.30am. Students must ensure that they arrive at school by 08.15am and have signed in on EntrySign by the Sixth Form Office. If students do not have an exam until later in the day, they must arrive at least 20 minutes before the start of the exam and sign in on EntrySign.
