Re: Arrangements for GCSE Results Day Thursday 20th August 2026

I hope you and your families are safe and well. Please find below the details regarding the arrangements for GCSE Results Day on Thursday 20th August 2026.

School will be open for students collecting their results **from 9am to 10.30am**. Students should enter school via the front gate and make their way to the Main Hall to collect their results. Once the results have been collected students can then enrol for the Sixth Form. This will take place in the Main Hall building where the Sixth Form and Senior Leadership Team will be on hand to support and guide students through the enrolment process.

If you are unable to collect your results yourself, you are required to provide the school office with a stamped addressed envelope so your results can be posted to you. Alternatively, you can nominate a representative to collect the results upon your behalf by emailing whs.exams@woodcotehigh.org.uk, the representative collecting the results will need to provide photographic identification.

The school will analyse the core subject grades and will identify students whose marks may potentially be raised following a review of marking. In these specific cases, the school will cover the cost of the review and submit the request on behalf of the student.

In addition to this, all candidates have the option to request a review of marking for any subject. If your child wishes to request a review in a subject not identified by the school, the associated fee—typically between £40 and £50 per exam paper or unit—will be payable by the candidate.

Payments for candidate-initiated reviews should be made via **ParentPay**. If you would like to proceed with a review of marking, please contact the exams office via by 9th September 2026. Requests will be processed from the 2nd September 2026.
