Dear Parent/ Carer,

Re: Year 11 Pre-Public Exams (PPEs) – January 2024

Your Year 11 child will be sitting their second round of Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs) the week beginning 19th February until Wednesday 6th March 2024. These exams will give teachers vital information on areas of strength, areas of development and any misconceptions students may have on an individual level.

Students should utilise half term, as well as the weeks running up to the exams, to revise and consolidate learning from across Year 10 and 11. With this in mind, we have asked the curriculum leaders of all subjects to provide key revision information to support this preparation. The information will be on Show My Homework (SMHW) and also on the Year 11 MS Teams Channel, this is to support students focus and to inform parents so they can support accordingly. We have also asked all subject teachers to ensure homework that is set are revision tasks only. Please see attached the PPE 2 timetable and note that student support sessions and Saturday Masterclasses will not run during this period.

All exams will be held in our exam venues and will be overseen by exam invigilators. Students are responsible for bringing the correct equipment for exams and are advised to check what they need, in advance, with their subject teachers.

Students regular timetabled lessons will continue, and all students are expected to attend these throughout the exam period, unless they are sitting an examination. Students will need to ensure that they bring their timetabled lesson resources as well as their own revision materials to ensure structured, focused lessons and revision.

Students will be dismissed home directly from afternoon exams but if they do not have an exam in the afternoon, they will be expected to attend lessons and pm registration as normal. All examinations finish Monday on 4th March 2024 except for those in practical exams on Tuesday and Wednesday.

We would be most grateful if you could take the time to discuss the PPE 2 timetable with your child and ensure your child is fully prepared for these exams.
