RE: Year 12 Work experience Summer 2026

The year 12 work experience placements will be taking place from **Monday 13th July to Friday 17th July 2026**. This provides students with five days of work-related learning with the opportunity to experience the world of work, develop an insight into working practices including the implementation of policies and procedures and the role of an employee in a specific sector.

Work experience provides students with a unique insight into the operations of an organisation and how to develop communication skills whilst interacting with professionals in their place of work.

The students will be asked to provide details about the employer and the placement, the expectations they will need to follow whilst on placement and the student's information will be shared with the employer.

You should aim to complete the placement form on Unifrog by Friday 20th March 2026. This allows enough time to complete all the forms and insurance requirements for work experience.

Year 12 students can also talk to their form tutor and be proactive by liaising with family and friends for possible placements. If your young person requires support with contact information to help to secure a work placement and writing emails to employers, they can see Ms. Bhogal in:

The most important aspect of work experience is the ability to demonstrate work related skills including reliability, organisation, ability to prioritise, work with other people and good communication skills. It is not always possible to obtain a specific placement, but the key thing is to develop employability skills which demonstrate the use of interpersonal skills.
