  - Bali
- Resource management
  - UK food, water and energy
  - Energy security in the UK
- Graph skills



**Mathematical and practical skills can also be assessed across these papers**

The exam will be 45 minutes long and will consist of four sections: Location and place, Physical Geography, Human Geography and Geographical Skills. It is out of 45.

The paper will contain a variety of question types including:

- multiple choice
- short answer questions
- longer answer questions
- practical skills questions.

You must answer all questions in the paper. You will need a black pen, pencil, ruler and calculator for the exam.
