- African American soldiers in the Vietnam War



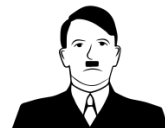
- **The First World War**

- Causes: MAIN and assassination of Franz Ferdinand
- Life in the trenches



- **The Second World War**

- Causes: Treaty of Versailles, Hitler's actions, League of Nations, Wall Street Crash and Great Depression, Appeasement
- Key turning points: Dunkirk, Battle of Britain, Pearl Harbour, Operation Barbarossa, D-Day



Your paper is 40 marks and you will have 45 minutes to complete this. You must answer all questions in the paper.

The papers will contain a variety of question types including:

- short answer questions
- longer answer questions
- source analysis questions

You will need a black pen and highlighter for the exam.
