To register as a candidate, a young person must:

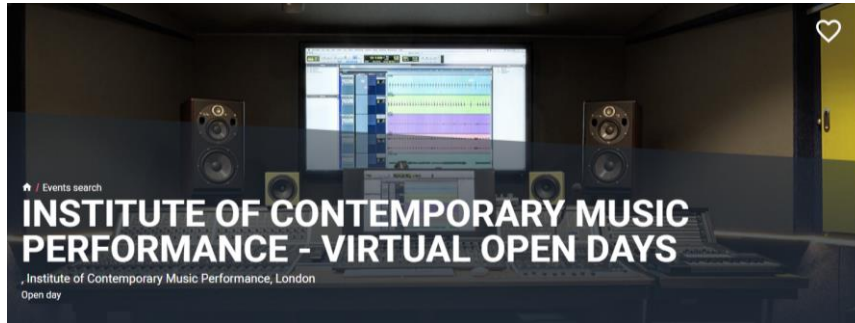
- Achieved 4/C or above in English and Maths GCSE (or equivalent)
- Completed GCSEs and A levels (or equivalent) at a state school
 1. Currently living and studying in the UK
 2. Eligible to work in the UK
 3. Aged 16-25
 4. Achieved 4/C or above in English and Maths GCSE (or equivalent)
 5. Completed GCSEs and A levels (or equivalent) at a state school
 6. **And at least one of the following is applicable:**
 7. At the age of 14, your highest paid parent/guardian did **not** have a professional position (see our application form for more details);
 8. OR you were eligible for free school meals during your time at school;
 9. OR neither parent completed a university degree in the UK.
