Title	Year 10 End of Year Exam Revision Guidance
Purpose	To provide revision information for End of Year Examinations

You will sit Literature Paper 2 - Modern Texts and Poetry

In the exam, you must answer **one** question from **Section A**, **one** question from **Section B** and **both** questions in **Section C**

You are advised to spend **45 minutes** on each section.

The maximum mark for this paper is 96.

AO4 will be assessed in **Section A**. There are 4 marks available for AO4 in Section A in addition to 30 marks for answering the question. AO4 assesses the following skills: use a range of vocabulary and sentence structures for clarity, purpose and effect, with accurate spelling and punctuation.

There are 30 marks for **Section B** and 32 marks for **Section C**

In the exam booklet, there will be all the texts examined by AQA, but you must only focus on An Inspector Calls [AIC], Power and Conflict Anthology and Unseen Poetry.

Section A: An Inspector Calls. You are advised to spend 45 minutes on this section.

You will be given two questions. You must choose one to answer.

Ensure to revise the following topics: Mr Birling, Mrs Birling, Eric, The conflict between the older and the younger generation, social responsibility and guilt

Section B: Power and Conflict Anthology. You are advised to spend 45 minutes on this section.

You will be provided with one poem you have studied, and you must compare to another poem in the anthology that is comparable.

Ensure to revise the following topics: - Ideas of Conflict; Effects of Conflict; Consequences of Conflict on Individuals – Exposure, Poppies, War Photographer, Kamikaze, Remains

Section C: Unseen Poetry. You are advised to spend 45 minutes on this section

You will be provided with two poems you have not studied, and you will have two questions to answer.

The first question will ask you to analyse how methods are used to present an idea in the first poem and the second question will ask you to compare the similarities and/or differences in the poem.

The exam will be 2 hours 15 minutes long and you must answer one question in each section for Section A and B and two from Section C.

You will sit Language Paper 2 - Writers' viewpoints and perspectives

In the exam, you will be provided with an insert that has two non-fiction sources. One of the sources will be from the 19th Century and the other 21st Century.

You are advised to spend 15 minutes reading through the sources.

The maximum mark for this paper is 80.

There are 40 marks for Section A and 40 marks for Section B.

You will be assessed on the quality of your **reading** in Section A.

You will be assessed on the quality of your **writing** in Section B.

Section A: You are advised to spend 45 minutes on this section

Question 1: Will require you to choose four statements that are TRUE from a selection on eight statements.

Question 2: Will require you to write about what you can INFER from the two sources on a particular idea. N.B. *This reflects the new change and if you're using older exam papers this question will be slightly different.*

Question 3: Focuses on AO2 so will ask you to analyse how LANGUAGE has been used to convey a particular idea.

Question 4: Is a comparative question that focuses on the PERSPECTIVES or ATTITUDES of the WRITERS on a subject within the sources.

Section B: You are advised to spend 45 minutes on this section.

This is your transactional writing task. You will be asked to write an article or speech. You must pay close attention to the FORM, AUDIENCE and PURPOSE of the task.

The exam will be 1 hour 45 minutes long and will consist of five questions.
